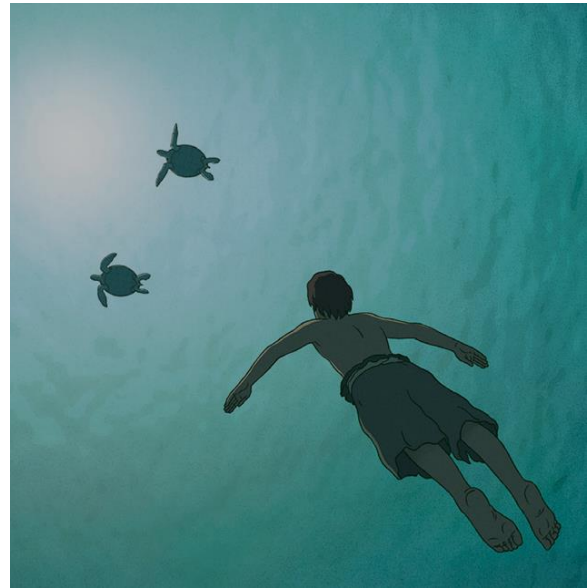

Michael Dudok de Wit (1953, the Netherlands) is an animator, director and illustrator. In 1978, he graduated from the West Surrey College of Art with his first film *The Interview*. His film *The Monk and the Fish* (1994) was nominated for an Oscar and has won numerous prizes including a César Award for Best Short Film and the Cartoon d'Or.

His most well-known film *Father and Daughter* (2000) won an Academy Award, a BAFTA Award, the Grand Prix at Annecy, and dozens of other major awards. This was followed by *The Aroma of Tea* (2006), an experimental film painted entirely with tea. He is currently directing his first animated feature, *The Red Turtle*, in Angoulême, France.

Michael also writes and illustrates children's picture books and teaches animation at art colleges and universities in England and abroad.
